


ELECTROCARDIOGRAM OF HEART



Electrodes (seen at right) are attached to the patient's two arms, two legs, and six locations on the front of the chest.

The ECG produces a graphical display of heart rate and rhythm on the monitor and on paper. Michele Lively, RRT, often administers the test.

What is It? Phillips Pagewriter TC70 Cardiograph

Year Acquired: 2011

How It Works: In the emergency room, an electrocardiogram (ECG or EKG) is quickly administered for helping the doctor or PA determine if a heart attack occurred. The machine makes a graphical record of the heart's electrical activity. Irregular "waves" on the graph indicate areas of damage or impaired blood flow to the heart.
