EMS MONITOR TRACKS VITAL SIGNS



Paramedic Scott Neu attaches vital sign leads from the patient to the monitoring device. The monitor can quickly indicate whether the patient's heart and lung functions are worsening.

What is It?

Zoll X Series Monitor, acquired in 2015

Purpose:

Give medics answers to what is going on with the patient's airway, breathing, and blood circulation. The monitor picks up subtle changes, breath by breath, in key vital signs. Medics can look for early warning of worsening trends. The readings can be acted upon en route and communicated to the emergency room.

How It Works:

Numerous measuring devices can be hooked up, ranging from something as simple as a body temperature gauge to the more complex heart ECG or heart defibrillator. Some readings tell the medics how effective they are in their actions to open an airway or do CPR chest compressions.
